Fellowship Picnic



MISSION MOMENT (PASTOR KIM)

More than a century ago, a legacy of caring was born when John and Mary Warren founded Colorado Christian Home as an orphanage in 1904 in Loveland, Colo. The campus may have changed a bit since the early days, but that legacy lives on today at Tennyson Center for Children. Today they are one of the Rocky Mountain region's leading treatment centers for abused, neglected and at-risk youth. Tennyson Center was the first licensed day treatment program in Colorado back in 1981. They moved into their new, state-of-the-art facility back in 1996; and was recognized as a leader in not only the healing and protection of children from abuse and neglect, but also in the efforts to help children with mental health and developmental issues. We are helping this month in their "Dress a Child" campaign where \$180 can go a long way in preparing one child for the new school year.
