passage says that Christ always was, as if to say that God's love for us was not simply the result of sin, but part of His intention and

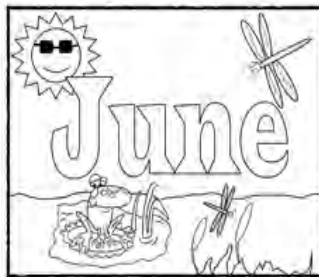
love for the world from the start, therefore we are called "light". In the midst of the worries of the world, of illness, sickness, and doubt, Christ's light shines.

## Father's Day Lunch!



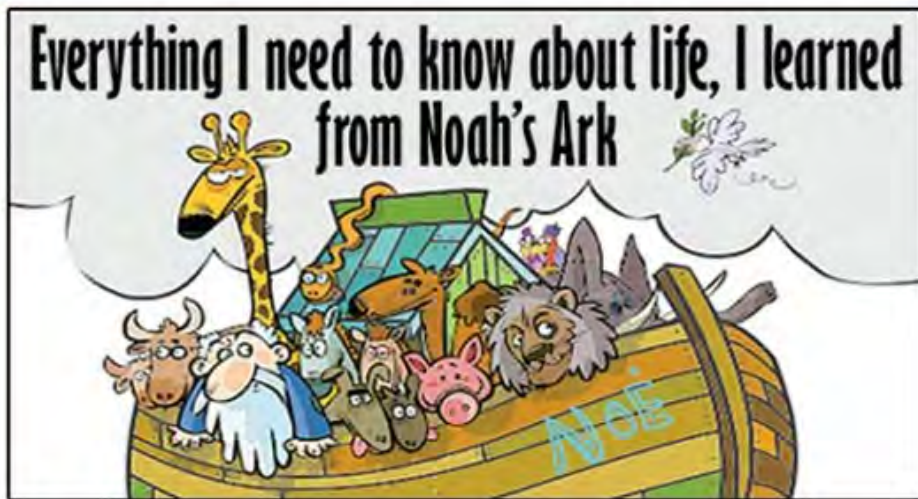

## Addition Update!

As I write this, the roof is almost done, the stucco will be done, the rough in plumbing is in, the electric will be run starting Monday, and the drywall on the inside part of the church is on. We are on target for a first of July completion.

As for the hail damage, the church will receive a new roof and widows in the sanctuary; the parsonage will get a new roof; and the barn will get a new roof. We may incur a little expense to get all of that done since the church roof is so old that depreciation played a part of the insurance payment for the damage. But when it is all completed, St. Paul's will not need to worry about roof problems for the next 15-20 years.

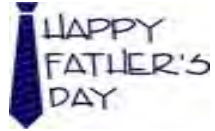

## MISSION MOMENT (PASTOR KIM)
