the heavens that God has prepared for all His children" and that this place, as John describes in the book of Revelation, the place of the "NO Moans" - no more tears, no more


sickness, no more death - brings all Christians strength and comfort to face any turmoil life

Women's Fellowship (Helen)



Safety First!

Everything is humming along smoothly with two Worship Services, masks, social distancing and seat reservations! Thanks to all who are helping and participating! It is a new process for all of us, but everything is designed to keep all of us safe and healthy. In a time where COVID cases are spiking all over the country, we will endeavor to keep our church services and Bible Studies safe for all.

For Those Who Are Ready to Join Us...

For any who are ready to return to church, **the process is easy!** Contact Sharon by phone, email or text any time after 9 am Monday morning to reserve your seat for Sunday. It is that easy! There are two services to choose from 8:30am and 11am. Both services are fairly equally attended, currently with 20 - 25 people each. We also have wonderful greeters who will help you find your seat once you have arrived. Seats or seat groups are all 6' apart and masks are required!

Bible Studies follow the same in-church guidelines of 6' distancing and wearing masks. All Bible Studies are currently meeting in the sanctuary so we have enough room to meet safely. **Reservations are not needed for Bible Study!**

Always Safely Disinfected

We have a wonderful disinfection system which is both safe and effective. We are using hypochlorous acid or HOCL which can be made with tap water, a little salt and vinegar and a generator which charges the solution with an electrical current. HOCL is strong enough to kill 99.99% of contaminants and is **EPA approved for killing COVID-19**. Additionally, at the strength we are generating, it is FDA approved to spray directly on food which is then safe to eat without rinsing! It is a very mild, clear liquid with a slight chlorine odor which dissipates within a few minutes. It is completely safe on your skin, on your food, and now with a fogger, on your pews, cushions, carpets, restrooms and every surface you touch at the church. We are fully disinfecting the public areas of the church after every service and Bible Study. **Rest assured, your church is completely and effectively disinfected to keep our church family happy, healthy and safe!**


