
No Bible Studies in August (Pastor Kim)

Pastor Kim spoke to Santa Fe Glass about the poor quality workmanship they had done; they will correct the problem with no cost to us.


Council discussed having a church picnic in August (to be outside). Please let the Council know if you would like a pancake breakfast in September.
