I look forward to more years of growing together in the Kingdom of God.







## Rotini Pasta Salad (Phyllis)

As served at Fellowship July 31.

Boil, drain & cool: 3/4 box tri-colored Rotini pasta

Cut, chop and add: Cucumber

Tomatoes

Celery

I added, but optional: Black Olives

Frozen Peas

Parsley Flakes

1/2 bottle Italian Salad Dressing

For refreshments at church, this was doubled.  
Any number of items could be added.



## Blueberry Lemonade (Insider's Cookbook)

### INGREDIENTS

1 cup plus 2 tbsp. granulated sugar

2 cups water

1 pint fresh blueberries

1-1/2 cups freshly squeezed lemon juice

(from about 10 big lemons, including pulp but not seeds)

### INSTRUCTIONS

First make a simple syrup by combining 1 cup sugar and water in a saucepan over medium heat, stirring until the mixture boils. Lower the heat and allow the syrup to simmer for another minute. Remove from heat and let cool.

In a blender or food processor, puree the blueberries with 2 tablespoons of sugar. In a pitcher, combine the cooled syrup, lemon juice and blueberry puree.

To serve, pour 1/4 to 1/3 cup of base into a glass and fill with water. Makes base for 12 servings.

## Swedish Meatballs (Sharon)

As served at Fellowship during 50's week.

### INGREDIENTS

5-6 lb. bag of frozen meatballs (enough to fill large crock pot)

6 c. Beef Stock

6 c. Heavy Cream

1 c. Flour

1 c. Butter

3 Tbsp. Soy Sauce

3 Tbsp. Worcestershire Sauce

1 Tbsp. Black Pepper

1 Tbsp. Dried Rosemary, crushed

### INSTRUCTIONS

Melt butter in a large (5 Qt. ) pan. Blend in flour. Cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until thick and bubbly. (This happened almost immediately).

Remove from heat and slowly add broth and cream, stirring until smooth.

Return to heat. Stir in soy sauce, Worcestershire sauce, pepper and rosemary. Heat to a gentle boil, stirring constantly. Boil and stir one minute until thick.

Add frozen meatballs and sauce to large crock pot until full. (Additional sauce can be saved as extra gravy.)

Cook 4 1/2 to 5 hours on high, stirring halfway through.

May be served straight from the crock pot or spooned over egg noodles.
