The property and grounds work continues including tree trimming. Lawn/sprinklers and carpet repair/stretching.

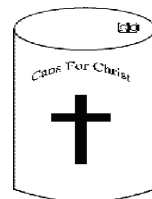
Pastor Kim will be on vacation June 15 through the 21st.
